WHO SHOULD COME?

Anyone who wants to receive information about the newly revised 21st Century Community Learning Request For Proposal.

WHO CAN APPLY FOR THIS GRANT?

All local educational agencies, community-based organizations, including faith-based organizations and other public or private organizations, or a consortium of two or more agencies, organizations, or entities that may include, but not limited to, local and regional boards of education, Regional Educational Service Centers applying on behalf of Local Education Agencies, charter and magnet schools are eligible to apply/receive funds from the State under this program, as long as they primarily serve students that attend schools with a high concentration of poor students, **giving priority to applicants serving children in low-performing schools.** This applies to all designated Title I and priority schools. The stipulation that a minimum of 40 percent of the student population identified as recipients of free/reduced lunch must be met.
